



IMAGINE A WORLD WITHOUT FACTORY FARMING.

Make It Possible in the classroom.

Your whole class might like to work on each activity; or perhaps you could form small groups with each group working on just one activity. Each of the activities here is designed to raise awareness about factory farming. In addition to making kind choices when you shop, the best way to help end factory farming is to spread the word. SPREAD THE WORD ONLINE

Create and share your own tweets and Facebook posts. Try to come up with 9-10 of them so you have a new one to post for every week of the term. Make posting a new one your weekly homework (playing on Facebook as homework? Score!).

Here's an example to get you started:

e.g. Life in a cage is no life at all. Cage eggs are cruel. Free hens from factory farms. #makeitpossible

COLLECT SIGNATURES

Make copies of the pledge sheet and collect as many signatures as possible around the school. Let people know what factory farming involves and then ask them to help animals by pledging to Make It Possible.

RAISE MONEY AND RAISE AWARENESS

Have fun with a fundraising activity at your school. You could have a cruelty-free bake-sale or raffle. Or get permission to have a sleep-over in the school gym or your classroom! Whatever event you choose, make sure you have flyers to distribute and a pledge sheet for other people who want to take the Make It Possible pledge.

MAKE A PRESENTATION

Make a presentation about factory farming that you can show to another class or at a school assembly. Make sure you use a mixture of pictures, video and yourself talking. At the end of your presentation (and once the applause has finally stopped!), have flyers ready to distribute and a pledge sheet for people who want to take the Make It Possible pledge. This is a great way to raise awareness!

TAKE THE MAKE IT POSSIBLE CLASSROOM PLEDGE

The more the merrier! Get your friends in other classes to take the online Classroom Pledge too. See if you can get your whole school involved in making life better for animals!

DESIGN POSTERS

Design posters about factory farming and display them around the school. You can put them in the window of your classroom facing out for everyone to see. Ask the library and front office if they'll let you display your posters there too.

CAGE-FREE CANTEEN

See what can be done to get rid of factory farmed products from your school canteen. This is the biggest project on this list. If you can achieve it though, you'll have scored a huge victory for the 12 million hens stuck in battery cages across Australia.
